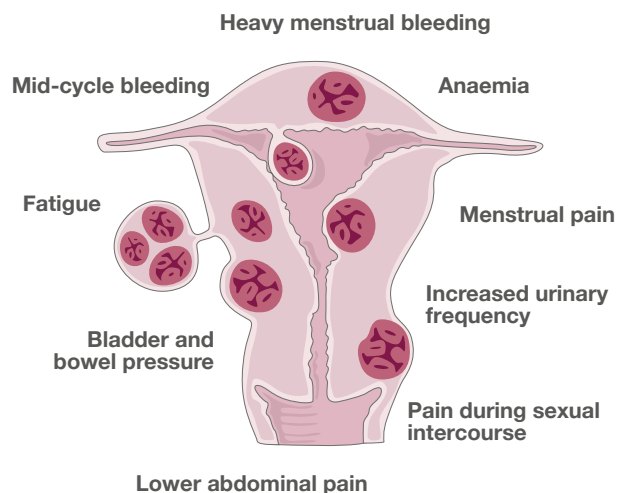


## Do you have the following symptoms?
